OUR WORK

Here are some highlights of our work showcasing our charitable donations that were made in addition to SAFE, Seedling, and Christmas Families.

In 2021, with us only being able to do 1 fundraiser (Juneteenth) the association purchased and donated Turkeys for every employee since the pandemic was still in its peak and we were unable to hold our annual Thanksgiving Office Potluck.

- Plus, we were still able to sponsor 10 families (**43 kids**) from Harris Elementary with Christmas presents.

In 2020, although unable to hold any in person fundraisers, we still managed to pull together present a donation check to San Marcos Police Officer – Justin Putnam's family to aid in any funeral expenses, in honor of their son who was killed in an ambush while responding to a domestic disturbance.

- Additionally, the association was able to present a donation check to our very own Sgt. Dale Multer's wife to aid in any funeral expenses when Sgt. Multer lost his battle to COVID-19.
- Sponsored 10 families (**35 kids**) from Metz-Sanchez Elementary with Christmas presents.

In 2019, the association sponsored one athlete to compete in the Miss Sweetheart Special Needs Pageant for Special Olympics.

- Later the same year when tragedy struck El Paso, Texas where 22 people lost their lives, the association along with the assistance of our employees, raised funds and donated to the El Paso Shooting Victims Fund.

In 2018, the association was asked to coordinate a fundraiser to help with medical expenses for both a current and former employee; and we did just that. With the help of our employees, and brisket taco sales, we were able to donate money to each of their medical expenses.

In an effort to give each employee an opportunity to present items that they would like to address to the board, each meeting will open with New Business discussions from guests. Our monthly scheduled meeting will occur the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 10:00 AM.
